Ironic timing, almost prophetic— Cole Supple’s first release in nearly two years, about the recovery and resilience of a young person making their way through the world, as everyone is trapped indoors living through the COVID-19 pandemic. But maybe this irony serves a purpose. Cole’s new six-song E.P., “Platinum Recovery” details the process of getting oneself out of a low time, learning to accept and interpret the waves of life, and never holding back from desiring and pursuing more— no matter what.

Musically and thematically, this is the most intense yet cohesive work Cole has ever produced. From lush string ballads to country&blues to pop to eclectic alternative rock, the musical landscape runs far and wide on this project. With musical influences like Maroon 5, Coldplay, George Harrison, and Jeff Buckley, there is something for everyone and nothing for no one on this record.

Themes in these new songs acknowledge the abstract, euphoric, and crazed feelings of loneliness, frustration, and boredom one experiences while working through a personal crisis. The E.P. equally expresses the importance of maintaining hope and using close relationships as anchors to lift oneself back up while being patient and accepting the passing of time as a crucial medicine.
